



Qualifications for Honor Society Certificate 2008

The Honor Society Certificate is based on the following Criteria:

- The NYI membership goal of each church should be set at 5% increase per year in the focused age of 12-23 with a goal of 500 per quadrennial for the district.
- The Honor Rating Certificate will be based on the following criteria:
 1. A gain in average weekly Sunday School attendance or youth hour.
 2. Each local NYI pays its portion of the district budget.
 3. A combined offering is taken for JFANG (Jesus for a New Generation and the NYI District Home Mission Project at a minimum of \$3.00 per youth Sunday School average of the local NYI. (The number is taken from the pastor's report of NYI Sunday School.)
 4. There are weekly, spiritually-based youth meetings.
 5. Each local NYI organizes, carries out and reports on a non-profit service project.
- Each local society must keep current and accurate records of active members, using our Nazarene supplies.

To be presented a certificate at the NYI convention, ***this completed form must be mailed in by June 1st*** (Sally Beach, c/o Church of the Nazarene, 258 Park Road, Garnett, KS 66032. Email: kshorselover@hotmail.com) Certificates will be presented Saturday during the convention proceedings. ***If you qualify for the certificate but do not submit this form by the deadline, you will receive your certificate by mail following the convention.***
