Dr. Jack Eystone is a native of Oklahoma and attended Bethany Nazarene College now known as Southern Nazarene University. He took his first church in Somerton, Arizona on July 1, 1960. In the 47 years of ministerial experience he has pastored churches in Arizona, California, and Washington State. He was active in pastoral ministries for 35 years. In 1993 Nazarene Bible College conferred an Honorary Doctorate of Ministries Degree on Rev. Eystone. In 1994 Dr. Eystone was elected District Superintendent of the Missouri District Church of the Nazarene. In July 2006 Dr. Eystone retired from that position and went into full time evangelism. In December 2008, Dr. Eystone became the Senior Pastor at Arlington Avenue Church of the Nazarene in Riverside California.

You can explore a cave on the retreat grounds, or you can just relax and enjoy the beautiful surroundings of the Ozarks and marvel at God's handiwork.

Directions: Windermere Baptist Conference Center is located on the Lake of the Ozarks, 9 miles west of Camdenton, Mo. Turn off Highway 54 on Highway AA (Roach, Mo.), which is 5 miles west of Camdenton, and follow the Windermere signs. The emergency number is 573-346-5200.

What to Bring: Bring any fishing or other sporting equipment you plan to use. Also bring games and refreshments for the "after hours" fellowship. Don't forget your Bible! ***Please bring your cameras (video/digital) to help make a DVD to promote future Laymen's Retreats!**

Clothing: Temperatures are variable in September, so plan accordingly. Bring warm clothes for outdoor activities. Casual clothes can be worn anytime and is encouraged for all services. There will not be an opportunity to change after the service on Sunday because of the check out time of 11:00 am from our rooms.

Accommodations: All rooms are priced according to the schedule on the registration form. Motel: Most of the modern rooms have a double bed and two single beds. Please indicate when you pre-register whom you would like to stay with. Linen and towels are provided in these rooms. Cedar Grove Cabins: These modern cottages consist of four separate rooms with private baths and private entrances. One couple is assigned per room or up to three singles per room. Linen and towels are NOT provided. RV Park: Full hookups are available. The park also has a shower house.

Payment for Retreat Available: The cost of the Retreat can be paid in payments by sending them to Joe Wright, treasurer. Any balance will be due at the Retreat. Special Rates: If you can only attend one night, special rates can be arranged by calling 417-753-2924; a reservation will be necessary to reserve a room.
