Directions: Windermere Baptist Conference Center is located on the Lake of the Ozarks, 9 miles west of Camdenton, Mo. Turn off Highway 54 on Highway AA (Roach, Mo.), which is 5 miles west of Camdenton, and follow the Windermere signs. The emergency number is 573-346-5200.

Saturday Afternoon Activities:

Windermere has various recreational activities available including tennis, volleyball, horseshoes, ping -pong, fishing and boating. Equipment activities can be rented at the front desk or the boat dock. You can explore a cave on the retreat grounds, or you can just relax and enjoy the surroundings of the Ozarks and marvel at God's handiwork.

The park also has a shower house.
