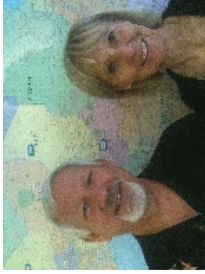

Biography of Howie & Beverly Shute: The Shutes have served on the Africa Region since December 1997. Beginning in December 2008 Howie has been serving as the **Assistant to the Africa Regional Director**, responsible for church multiplication and development throughout the continent. Beverly has been serving as the **Regional Personnel Coordinator** (HOA) as *Field Director and Field Strategy Coordinator* for the Church of the Nazarene. In these eleven years the Church grew from less than 200 persons worshipping in local Nazarene churches to more than 200,000. During this time the Shutes opened the work for the Church of the Nazarene in the Sudan and in two creative access countries. Church planting Movements (CPMs) have been taking place in several people groups in the HOA, resulting in hundreds of new churches planted annually. In addition to the HOA, we are now experiencing Church Planting Movements in Northern Ghana, Northern Togo, Northern Benin, Southern Burkina Faso, Southern Niger, and Western Nigeria (the Savano-Sahelian Corridor). Most recently CPMs have started in Northeast South Africa, the Transkei, and Lesotho. Biography of Jessica Morris: The Lord is currently leading me on a new and exciting journey because in the summer of 2009 I left Palermo, Italy, (where I worked for four and a half years as a church planter through the ministry of a coffeehouse and humanitarian foundation) to move back to Sofia, Bulgaria. Bulgaria is a place well known to me because after attending SNU in Oklahoma, USA, I spent 2 ½ years serving there as a Mission Corps Volunteer. In Bulgaria I am working to support the churches in Western Bulgaria, help restart the Sofia First Church of the Nazarene, coordinate Work and Witness, and organize the theological education classes in Bulgaria (something that I also did in Italy and Southeastern Europe from Palermo). Home used to be for me a small town in Arkansas, USA, where farming was the primary profession to be had, and we didn't even have a stoplight (still don't in fact). Your mail had to be picked up in person from the post office and our address was "General Delivery, Goshen, AR, 72735". Born the eldest of four children, our house and sprawling yard was the neighborhood playground and we learned early on to be imaginative and inventive. I saw in the lives of my parents a deep commitment to the Word of God both in their immersion in the Scriptures and it's implementation in their daily lives. Some highlights from along the journey include four and a half fabulously formative years of study at the Nazarene Theological Seminary in Kansas City and serving one year as an associate pastor in Fayetteville, Arkansas. There are many things that I enjoy doing such as hiking, playing the guitar, reading, hanging out with friends, swimming and snorkeling, prayer times with other people, biking anywhere I can, playing indoor soccer, and traveling. I feel myself to be at the start of an incredible journey that is changing and growing because it's a journey with God. God is challenging me daily to seek his presence and depend solely on him instead of on my own resources. I think that this can best be summed up in the following Russian proverb: "Go Godward; you will find a road."

Biography of Rich & Betty Crow: Rich and Betty Crow are Specialized Assignment missionaries for the Church of the Nazarene assigned to the Eurasia Regional office. They have previously served as missionaries on the Africa Region. Both Rich and Betty are graduates of Southern Nazarene University with Bachelors' and Masters' degrees. Rich has a background in business and management and has spent many years in the building and insurance industries. Betty has a retired school psychologist. In their current assignments Rich is the regional building, Work and Witness and Alabaster coordinator. Betty is the statistical secretary for the Eurasia Region. The Crows have lived by the philosophy that one needs to be available and of service to the building of God's Kingdom whenever and where ever He calls. More than thirty years ago God called them into missions and they have served various places as doors for ministry have opened. Their current assignments present some exciting challenges as they work to move the church forward and bring international leaders into more significant roles of responsibility. The training and support they will be giving to National leaders is vital to the future of the international church. During most of this assignment the Crows have been focusing particularly on South Asia because of the rapid growth in this area of the world. The growth is as rapid as in the days of the early church of the New Testament. Building needs far exceed the church's financial resources and they will be engaged to find remedies and resources to meet this critical need. It is a real pleasure for them to be given the opportunity to join in the great work that God is doing in this area. Rich and Betty are currently living in Budapest, Hungary and traveling the Eurasia Region.

Biography of Rusty & Diane Robbins: Rusty was born in Houston, Texas but spent his early years in Illinois. Thanks to his father's job with IBM he also has fond memories of living in Okinawa, Japan. Rusty is a graduate of Southern Nazarene University (SNU) with a degree in Accounting. SNU is where he met his wife Diane. Additionally, he is working toward completion of a degree for a Masters in Business Administration (MBA). By God's grace, Rusty experienced success in the business world working in the healthcare and telecommunications industries. Diane was born in Dallas, Texas and adopted to a couple when three days old. She too is a graduate of SNU with a business degree and is also pursuing an MBA. Diane's background is working in the nonprofit sector where she has done fund raising and volunteer development for health care and faith-based organizations. After eight years of service at the camp, God directed them to accept a call to work at JESUS Film Harvest Partners and serve as missionaries for the Church of the Nazarene on special assignment. Their current responsibilities allow them to share the love of God with the lost to fulfill the great commission. Rusty is the Field Services Coordinator and is responsible for working with all 300+ JESUS Film teams around the world. Additionally, he works with District Superintendents, pastors and others wishing to experience the move of the Holy Spirit in the JESUS Film settings around the world. Diane is the Field Communications Specialist and works with NMI Presidents and District JESUS Film Council Representatives to share the work of the ministry with the local body. Rusty and Diane consider it a blessing to be part of the work of the body of Christ around the world.
