## Finish the Verse Memory Verse Challenge (32 verses in 15 minutes)

- Hebrews 1:1-2** **In the past God spoke** to our forefathers through the prophets at many times and in various ways, but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom he made the universe.
- Hebrews 2:1** **We must pay more careful** attention, therefore, to what we have heard, so that we do not drift away.
- Hebrews 2:18** **Because he himself suffered when** he was tempted, he is able to help those who are being tempted.
- Hebrews 3:12-13** **See to it, brothers, that** none of you has a sinful, unbelieving heart that turns away from the living God. But encourage one another daily, as long as it is called Today, so that none of you may be hardened by sin's deceitfulness.
- Hebrews 4:12** **For the word of God** is living and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.
- Hebrews 5:7** **During the days of Jesus'** life on earth, he offered up prayers and petitions with loud cries and tears to the one who could save him from death, and he was heard because of his reverent submission.
- Hebrews 6:10** **God is not unjust; he** will not forget your work and the love you have shown him as you have helped his people and continue to help them.
- Hebrews 6:12** **We do not want you** to become lazy, but to imitate those who through faith and patience inherit what has been promised.
- Hebrews 7:25** **Therefore he is able to** save completely those who come to God through him, because he always lives to intercede for them.
- Hebrews 8:10** **This is the covenant I** will make with the house of Israel after that time, declares the Lord. I will put my laws in their minds and write them on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be my people.
- Hebrews 9:27-28** **Just as man is destined** to die once, and after that to face judgment, so Christ was sacrificed once to take away the sins of many people; and he will appear a second time, not to bear sin, but to bring salvation to those who are waiting for him.
- Hebrews 10:23-24** **Let us hold unwaveringly to** the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful. And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds.
- Hebrews 10:26-27** **If we deliberately keep on** sinning after we have received the knowledge of the truth, no sacrifice for sins is left, but only a fearful expectation of judgment and of raging fire that will consume the enemies of God.
- Hebrews 11:1** **Now faith is being sure** of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see.
- Hebrews 11:6** **And without faith it is** impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.
- Hebrews 12:3** **Consider him who endured such** opposition from sinful men, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart.
- Hebrews 12:14** **Make every effort to live** in peace with all men and to be holy; without holiness no one will see the Lord.
- Hebrews 13:4** **Marriage should be honored by** all, and the marriage bed kept pure, for God will judge the adulterer and all the sexually immoral.
- Hebrews 13:5** **Keep your lives free from** the love of money and be content with what you have, because God has said, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you."
- 1 Peter 1:15-16** **But just as he who** called you is holy, so be holy in all you do; for it is written: "Be holy, because I am holy."
- 1 Peter 1:24-25** **For, "All men are like** grass, and all their glory is like the flowers of the field; the grass withers and the flowers fall, but the word of the Lord stands forever." And this is the word that was preached to you.
- 1 Peter 2:15** **For it is God's will** that by doing good you should silence the ignorant talk of foolish men.
- 1 Peter 2:24** **He himself bore our sins** in his body on the tree, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; by his wounds you have been healed.
- 1 Peter 3:12** **For the eyes of the** Lord are on the righteous and his ears are attentive to their prayer, but the face of the Lord is against those who do evil."
- 1 Peter 3:15-16** **But in your hearts set** apart Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect, keeping a clear conscience, so that those who speak maliciously against your good behavior in Christ may be ashamed of their slander.
- 1 Peter 4:8** **Above all, love each other** deeply, because love covers over a multitude of sins.
- 1 Peter 4:11** **If anyone speaks, he should** do it as one speaking the very words of God. If anyone serves, he should do it with the strength God provides, so that in all things God may be praised through Jesus Christ. To him be the glory and the power for ever and ever. Amen.
- 1 Peter 5:6-7** **Humble yourselves, therefore, under God's** mighty hand, that he may lift you up in due time. Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you.
