Just clarify the change for this year: The morning bracket (elimination rounds) determines the teams for the afternoon brackets (finals rounds) with higher and lower competition based on performance (win/loss/points). The top team for the upper division will take home the BIG traveling trophy and the top team from the lower division will take home the Smaller traveling trophy. The morning individual results will be tallied for the yearly individual awards. - Hebrews 1:1-2** **In the past God spoke** to our forefathers through the prophets at many times and in various ways, but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom he made the universe.
- Hebrews 2:1** **We must pay more careful** attention, therefore, to what we have heard, so that we do not drift away.
- Hebrews 2:18** **Because he himself suffered when** he was tempted, he is able to help those who are being tempted.
- Hebrews 3:12-13** **See to it, brothers, that** none of you has a sinful, unbelieving heart that turns away from the living God. But encourage one another daily, as long as it is called Today, so that none of you may be hardened by sin's deceitfulness.
- Hebrews 4:12** **For the word of God** is living and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.

- Hebrews 10:26-27** **If we deliberately keep on** sinning after we have received the knowledge of the truth, no sacrifice for sins is left, but only a fearful expectation of judgment and of raging fire that will consume the enemies of God.
- Hebrews 11:1** **Now faith is being sure** of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see.
- Hebrews 11:6** **And without faith it is** impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.
- Hebrews 12:3** **Consider him who endured such** opposition from sinful men, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart.
- Hebrews 12:14** **Make every effort to live** in peace with all men and to be holy; without holiness no one will see the Lord.
- Hebrews 13:4** **Marriage should be honored by** all, and the marriage bed kept pure, for God will judge the adulterer and all the sexually immoral.
